We hope you enjoyed the video! Spend at least 30 minutes responding to the questions below. Single guys do this on your own or with a friend; fathers and sons do this together in a dedicated one-on-one time. Pray before you begin, asking God to show you the

	truth and change your heart to become more Christlike. (Tip: If you think a particular question is not beneficial, or you can't seem to think of a response –it happens – simply move on to the next one)		
>	Discuss: What are the main points or images you remember from the video?		
>	Discuss: The video began with a father and son having a discussion in their home before the son left to go into the world. What did you notice about their relationship that was good? What do you notice about your father and son relationship that is good?		
>	Write: Read Malachi 4:6 and John 13:7. The father and son in the video love each other but are disconnected at a heart level. Why is it important for a father to learn to discover the motivations in his son's heart?		
>	Discuss: The better the relationship between a father and son, the more the son benefits. Why do you think this is? List as many reasons as you can.		
>	Discuss: Read Ephesians 6:10-13 aloud. How do the video images (father, son, cowboys, shooting, jail etc.) illustrate this passage? How does all this relate to your personal struggle to do what is right?		
>	List: Satan's primary weapons are lies. List as many lies as you can that Satan might use to lead people astray. Write each one under the corresponding "Battle Front" (For example, the lie that financial victory is more important than spiritual victory would be part of the Cultural Battle Front).

>	Write: List the top three lies from Satan that you are prone to believe. What is the corresponding biblical truth? (If you don't know the corresponding truth, study the bible on this topic or get help from a pastor)
